

## **Buffalo Alert**

We would like to notify you that buffaloes have been spotted in the vicinity of Sowa township and the mine area, including the Wellfields. While efforts are underway, in collaboration with other stakeholders, to safely relocate these animals, they currently present a potential threat to the safety of our community members.

In light of this, we recommend the following precautionary measures to minimize any risks:

Below cautionary measures are recommended to avoid being a victim:

- 1. <u>Avoid Outdoor Activities</u>: It is advisable to refrain from outdoor activities such as jogging or leisurely walks.
- 2. <u>Exercise Caution at All Times:</u> Employees and contractors should exercise caution, even within the mine premises. There is a possibility that the buffaloes may access the mine area from various directions beyond our security controls.
- 3. <u>Monitor Children:</u> Parents and guardians, please closely monitor the movements of children and ensure they do not engage in street play during this time.
- 4. <u>Maintain a Safe Distance:</u> If you encounter buffaloes, keep a safe distance and avoid approaching them. Buffaloes may perceive humans as threats and could react defensively.
- 5. <u>Stay in Your Vehicle:</u> If you come across buffaloes while driving, remain inside your vehicle and refrain from taking close-up pictures.
