Incident Description

Whilst being towed from the Garage Workshop, a diesel bowser trailer decoupled from an light duty vehicle (LDV) and crashed into the Stores fence.

Body part / Nature of Damage

- Stores fence

Preliminary Findings?

- **Lack of attention** – The operator did not ensure that the trailer latch was fully secured on the LDV.
- **Use of defective equipment** – The safety chain of the trailer was broken.
- The was no fire extinguisher on the diesel bower.
- The driver was in possession of a valid driver's authorization.
- The driver was alco tested and results were negative.

Preventative& Corrective Measures

- The incident was reported to the relevant personnel.
- The diesel bowser trailer was put out of use until all defects identified are fixed
- The section was briefed on the incident.
- Employees must not use defective equipment.
- Employees must be fully engaged when performing their tasks.
- Conduct a minewide inspection of all bowsters to ensure they comply.
