


## **SAFETY TOPIC - MAY 2023**

## **ENSURE YOUR OWN AND COLLEAGUES SAFETY**



## To ensure personal and coworker safety, follow the tips below;

- **Keep work areas clean-** Injuries such as slips, trips, falls, lacerations, sprains, strains, etc. can be reduced by keeping work areas organized and clean.
- Use the right tool for the job- Using the wrong tool for the job can result in an injury or damage to the
  equipment.
- Always wear the proper PPE for the task- It helps to reduce the severity of the impact.
- Never work on live equipment- Always follow proper lock out/tag out procedures prior to maintenance of equipment.
- Make sure chemicals are properly labelled and stored- Improper labeling and storage can lead to injuries or property loss due to fires, corrosion, etc.
- Communicate hazards to other personnel- Never assume that a coworker understands the hazards of a task, especially if they are new to the task.
